Diane Flamand graduated from Oenology School of Bordeaux in 1987 and went on to earn her Masters Degree in International Wine and Spirit Trade at ESC Dijon. She began her training as a winemaker at Château Lafite Rothschild, Lynch-Bages and Pichon Longueville Baron in Pauillac. In 1997, Diane was appointed as Training Manager at BARTON & GUESTIER (Blanquefort – Bordeaux) in charge of B&G "Wine Training Program" and the promotion of the brand in France and abroad. She spent several months abroad in California at Sterling Vineyard and in South Africa during the harvest for the vinifications. Diane joined DBR (Lafite) as Collection Wines Manager in 2004.

LAURENT-PERRIER



Alexandra & Stephanie de Nonancourt

Co-Owners

Having been handed the reins of Champagne's largest family-owned house, Laurent-Perrier, after the death of their father Bernard in 2010, the sisters Nonancourt now run the fourth largest

house in the region in terms of both bottles shipped and turnover. They preside over 150 hectares of vineyard land, buying 89% of their grapes in, which go into creating the house's 7.2 million bottles. In addition to Laurent-Perrier, the Nonancourts also own the highly prized Salon Champagne, Delamotte, and Vicomte de Castellane. Since taking control, the sisters have invested heavily in the new cuverie for prestige cuvée Grand Siècle, along with the launch of magnums and Jeroboams of library wine Grand Siècle Les Reserves.

NONINO



Giannola Nonino

Owner Family

The generations that followed produced grappa in the same ancestral manner, but it was when Giannola, the visionary matriarch, married into the family in 1962 that Nonino was shaken from its dormancy. While Benito Nonino distilled the grappa, his wife Giannola developed many of the ideas, and packaging that helped raised Benito's work to such prominence. Intuitively understanding the importance of marketing, Giannola bottled this artisanal distillate in a distinctive, bulbous glass container normally used for perfume. Labels, personally signed by Giannola, indicated the production year, similar to how wine indicates a vintage. Launching what could be considered one of the first influencer campaigns, she sent bottles of grappa to celebrities and the Italian elite. Giannola is the woman who revolutionized grappa. Today their three daughters are thoroughly involved in running Nonino.

She is a multi-award winning winemaker, wine judge and a cool climate enthusiast, is a firm believer in the philosophy 'wine is made in the vineyard'. She humbly attributes the beautiful Riesling coming from Pewsey Vale to the perfect pairing of the grape variety and vineyard site. Not only does she hold down dual winemaker positions, but she is also Director of the Australian Wine Research Institute, an active member of wine industry councils and advisory boards, and is frequently a judge at wine shows.
