

VALENTINE ZUSSLIN



Marie Zusslin Winemaker and Owner

At Domaine Valentin Zusslin, where Marie Zusslin and her brother, Jean-Paul, have managed the estate since 2008. Established in 1691 by M. Jodocus CISLE (former name of Zusslin), Domaine Valentin ZUSSLIN is now run by two generations of the their forbears.

Zusslin family who are following in the footsteps of The winery is based in Orschwihr, south of Colmar, and the vines are planted on the slopes of the Bollenberg, Clos Liebenberg and Grand Cru Pfingstberg. In 1997 the domaine converted to biodynamic viticulture. Much of the work in the vineyard and in the cellar is done by hand, in order that the grapes can express the full

potential of the unique terroirs of the Domaine. "It is the most fascinating work, you have to deal with the nature, follow the rhythm of the plants, to observe the environment. You have to be modest face to all the elements and be in

relation to them. My goal: sublimate the Terrroirs."
